Tdap vaccine for 6th Grade

Just a reminder for parents of a student entering 6th grade next fall:



Students 11 years or older entering 6th grade are required to have one dose of Tdap. A dose received at 7 years of age or older will meet this requirement.

Students who are 10 years old in 6th grade and who have not yet received a Tdap vaccine are in compliance until they turn 11 years old.


Your child may not be permitted to attend school without the necessary verification of the immunization or proof of appointment for the immunization.
